

Who Qualifies Fo Membership?

All manufacturers associated in EUROMOT would welcome your participation provided your company's eligibility. EUROMOT membership is open to any company that manufactures internal combustion engines (diesel, petrol, gas) for any kind of industrial application like

- power generation, pumps, compressors;
- rail traction: locomotives & rail cars;
- · lawn, garden & recreational equipment;
- · nonroad mobile machinery: agricultural & forestry, material handling & ground support, construction & mining equipment;
- inland marine & seagoing vessels, workboats, pleasure boats.

EUROMOT member companies are devided into two categories of membership:

- Full members: Internal combustion engine (ICE) manufacturers with premises in 'Europe' may become
 full members with full voting rights. This includes any company providing significant R&D facilities or major
 production facilities in 'Europe' which is not primarily a trading business.
- ICE manufacturers with R&D and production facilities outside 'Europe' but with major market share in the European Union and the European Free Trade Association (EFTA) may become associate members. They are accepted on a case-by-case basis by the General Assembly.
